HOUSTON'S NEWEST ARTS ORGANIZATION LAUNCHES WITH AN EXHIBIT AT THE MUSEUM OF PRINTING HISTORY

PAPER & INK, the first annual exhibit of Houston's newest arts organization, will be on view from October 1 to January 23, 2010, at The Museum of Printing History. The exhibit will showcase original and mixed-media prints by the five founding members: Andis Applewhite, Vivian Hordes, Ann Johnson, Cathie Kayser, and Ruth Shouval. These artists have exhibited extensively, locally and nationally.

An artist will be in the gallery from 3-4 P.M. the third Saturday of each month—October 17, November 21, and December 19—to answer any questions about the exhibit, printmaking, print collecting, and the new organization.

PrintMatters was created to promote traditional and non-traditional printmaking, expand the Houston market of print collectors, and further the professional growth of its members. Future plans include an annual juried membership show; a biannual national juried exhibit; monthly critique sessions; and workshops with local and national master printers and educators.

THE MUSEUM OF PRINTING HISTORY

The Museum of Printing History displays a dynamic collection of historical documents, fine art prints, and antique printing equipment. The Museum is more, though, than its permanent collection. It is alive with exhibitions, lectures, workshops, and demonstrations. In its galleries and working studios, the Museum demonstrate the traditional processes of stone lithography, letterpress printing, papermaking, and bookbinding.
